## Rules on Creating a Corporate Team

## Creating a Corporate Team:

A company can register runners for the event as part of a corporate team. Just go to the registration link on the website. During the online registration, you'll get to the area that states, "Join or Create a Team (Optional)".

For each team you create, a team captain is created first. If you join a team, make sure you join one of your company's team and that the team captain is allowing you to be on that team.

Teams are gender neutral and are comprised of three team members. A company can have multiple teams competing in the same race.

Please note: Runners can compete as part of a team or individuals, but not both. In additiona, if a company has 15 people, they can have any combination of teams and runners, for example, they can have 3 teams, which would be a total of 9 people, and the other 6 people, can register as individuals to compete or to walk the event.

## Corporate Race Team Scoring Per Race

- The corporate team with the lowest total combined time for each race as measured by the electronic timing system is the winner.
- The first, second, and third place teams at each race will be awarded a team trophy for display at their office. Each participant will be also awarded a medal.
- The winners will be announced during the awards presentation at the end of the race.
